Overview

The Cinema Trailer app is a free showcase for the latest movie trailers and clips that doubles as a sales-channel for Virgin Movie rentals. The movie-lover is drawn into the app by the latest content about what's showing in cinemas and they are reminded at multiple points in their journey, using a soft-sell approach, to rent a Virgin Movies title.

The app consists of 3 main screens: a Menu Screen for browsing content, a Video Player Screen for watching movie trailers and clips, and a Movie Info Screen for reading about chosen movies.

The Menu Screen¹ contains multiple carousels, some containing portrait-style movie posters which link to movie trailers, and some containing landscape-style thumbnails which link to movie clips. Carousels are viewed one at a time.

To switch carousels the menu contracts when pressing UP or DOWN and when another menu item is selected the menu expands to reveal another carousel.


Pressing OK on a poster or thumbnail calls up an options popup called the 'Cross Picker2'.' This presents the user with 5 options which they access using the D-pad: pressing OK will play the video that was highlighted in the menu carousel. UP will jump to the Movie Info Screen for the chosen movie, DOWN will dismiss the pop-up, pressing RIGHT will take the user to a VOD movie they can rent, and LEFT will generally lead to related content.

The Video Player Screen³ plays single assets or playlists of videos. The SKIP FWD and SKIP BACK buttons, both onscreen and on the remote control, allow users to jump between assets on a playlist. Single asset players don't have skip buttons since there are no other videos to jump to.

The Movie Info Screen4 displays the details about a movie, some action buttons that apply to it, and links to related assets along the lower third. VOD assets have a 'Rent' button that cinema Movie Info Screens lack.

In-Cinema videos are linked to each other (eg. Trailers and interviews for the same movie) and to VOD rentals through metadata matching. Linking 'Similar movies' rentals (which appear on the Cross Picker and Movie Info Screens) could be done by grouping movies by genre keywords (for example, an action movie in the cinema could be grouped with other action movies in the VOD catalogue if they all share the 'action' genre metatag).









Overview



App Structure

The general user journey follows Menu Screen —> Video Player Screen —> Movie Info Screen, and then exiting the app by pressing a 'Rent' button a VOD Movie Info Screen (which leads to a core TiVo buy screen where users proceed with the rental). There are 3 'channels' a user can travel on when going from screen to screen: the Cinema Trailers channel, Cinema Clips channel (these are interviews, featurettes, and movie excerpts), or VOD Trailers channel. Users may journey in a linear way but are also free roam in a roundabout way,

and are presented at multiple points to land on a VOD Movie Info Screen (shown above in blue. See the 'Example User Journeys' section for common user stories and journeys).

Leanback Channels and Movie-Related Playlists


The layout encourges a leanback experience like watching a traditional TV channel, but the app also allows for playback of all the videos related to a specific movie. A Leanback Channel is triggered by pressing OK on a a thumbnail and then pressing OK on the Cross Picker. The entire channel of videos will play

starting with the chosen movie. When all videos in a channel are played the user is returned to the Menu Screen (with the focus on the thumbnail that launched the playlist).

However the user may also trigger playlists of clips related to a chosen movie. If a video has related clips a LEFT press on the Cross Picker will launch a single video or playlist of clips related to the selection (see Example User Journeys 4 & 6). If the user remains idle they will be sent to the Move Info Screen when the related clips(s) for that movie are finished playing.



GLOSSARY

Cinema trailer A trailer for a movie currently in cinemas. Clip Interview, featurette or movie excerpt.

OD trailer A trailer for a movie that can be rented from Virgin Movies.

Play Triggers playlist starting with asset that launched the Cross Picker.

Movie info Links to Movie Info Screen. Focus starts on 'Rent' button on VOD Movie Info Screen.

Similar movies Links to Movie Info Screen. Focus starts on similar titles available to rent.

Dismisse Cross Picker.

Related videos Links to interviews, featurettes, or clips related to a movie trailer.

Play trailer Links to single movie trailer related to a clip.

Time Display

A video's time display always appears in the upper right corner.

Times are displayed with hour, minute, and seconds digits separated by colons, like so:

HH:MM:SS

If a time is less than 9:59 minutes then display M:SS. Else if a time is less than 59:59 then display MM:SS. Else if a time is less than 9:59:59 then display H:MM:SS. Else display HH:MM:SS


The time display shows the current time and the duration separated by 2 spaces, a forward slash, and another 2 spaces. It is right justified. For example:






